January 2019 Rule Amendments

MOTION 8-2019: That a 12/13 year old Junior Division be added to the Competition Divisions section in the Light Kickboxing Ruleset. *W.Manicke / Z.Erber CARRIED*

MOTION 9-2019: That a specification be added to the Tournament Ruleset to set a minimum diameter requirement of 2" (51 mm) for padded weapons. *K.Delesoy / P.Gunnlaugson CARRIED*

MOTION 10-2019: That no home-made weapons be allowed for Padded Weapon Sparring Competition. *W.Manicke / C.Greenwood CARRIED*

MOTION 11-2019: That trapping techniques are included as a foul under section 4.4.6 for Sport Point Sparring Competition in the Tournament Ruleset. *M.Forster / Z.Erber CARRIED*

MOTION 12-2019: That sweeping techniques are included as a foul under section 4.4.6 for Sport Point Sparring Competition in the Tournament Ruleset. *M.Forster / T.Oehler CARRIED*

MOTION 13-2019: To adopt the weight divisions as defined by the International Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Federation (IBJJF) for standard SMAA grappling divisions. *M.Forster / K.Greenwood CARRIED*

January 2019 Rule Amendments

MOTION 16-2019: To remove punching as a legal technique in Padded Weapon Sparring matches. *W.Manicke / C.Greenwood CARRIED*

MOTION 17-2019: To revise the Light Kickboxing Ruleset to specify that a match will be stopped when blood is present. *Z.Erber / S.Silver CARRIED*

MOTION 18-2019: That in a Light Kickboxing match having been stopped because of blood being present, the center referee in conference with the corner officials will decide if a disqualification is warranted. And further that, in case of a no disqualification judgement, the officials will score the entire match as seen without consideration of the blood. *K.Delesoy / C.Greenwood CARRIED*

MOTION 19-2019: That a five minute limit be set to stop any bleeding and to clean and/or change out any equipment and clothing as required to allow them to compete in subsequent matches. And further that, a competitor shall participate in a subsequent match only upon approval of the center official. *C.Greenwood / M.Forster CARRIED*
